What is COVID-19?

Public health officials have identified a new coronavirus disease, COVID-19. The World Health Organization has declared the outbreak a public health emergency of international concern.

Symptoms of COVID-19: Respiratory symptoms Fever Cough Shortness of breath Trouble breathing

How does it spread?

Human coronaviruses may spread from an infected person to others through:

- · The air by coughing and sneezing
- Close personal contact, such as touching or shaking hands
- Touching an object or surface with the virus on it, then touching your mouth, nose or eyes before washing your hands

Person-to-person transmission is occurring to some extent with COVID-19.

Wash hands frequently

with soap and water. When soap and water aren't available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.



Minimize close contact

with people who have symptoms of respiratory illness.



Ensure proper use

of personal protective equipment (PPE) where appropriate.

Clean and disinfect

surfaces and high-touch objects with approved disinfectants.
